- 9. Changes of Competitions Regulations:
  - 1. Presnted the Proposed changes by EC SE
  - 2. Proposed by NFs (Ukraine, Denmark)

## **UKR: change of regulations.**

1. Propose to remove the X for 16 years old in the Women's senior, championships, cups and U22 since we now have an U15 tournament.

Indicative voting from present Federations: 10-4-4









2. Propose that the Top8 teams in the European Championships must have played in one of the junior championships in the previous 2 years.

Proposed new format: if top8 do not have youth program, they will move into the lower bracket.

U-22 is also youth

Two years should be replaced by two editions *Indicative voting from present Federations: 2-8-7* 

## **DEN: change of regulations**

1. MESC – reduce the number of teams per country to a maximum of four. *Indicative voting from present Federations: 0-7-8* 

2. Change the Calendars and have set dates for our Championships as we do for our Cups. *Indicative voting from present Federations: 3-6-8* 

All the proposals and the indicative results will be discussed in the Softball Commission for a final decision.

10. Competitions 2022 - 2029 situation

GW: There is a gap until 2025 and the Softball Commission will work on alternatives in Women's and Men's events.

11. Softball Europe Future in the new structure of WBSC Europe

GW: Great opportunity to unite with baseball. Start of a long journey. Good opportunity to vote.
