## **PRESIDENT'S CORNER**

Softball will not be in the 2016 Olympics. As is now well known, our sport was not nominated by the IOC Executive Committee to be considered in October for inclusion in the 2016 Games. This is very disappointing to us all.

The BackSoftball campaign was successful and ISF President Porter did everything to bring International Softball to IOC level. This included working to give us our own "image", increase the number of Federations worldwide, develop softball in Africa and Muslim countries and foster television coverage of the 2008 Olympics and the 2009 World Cup Oklahoma.

There was softball before the Olympics and there

will be softball after the Olympics. We have to realise, however, that many Federations will face a difficult time because the National Olympic Committees were supporting softball as member of the Olympic Family. Funding is now under pressure. To help these Federations must be our first concern. Also, and until we return to the "Olympic fold", we have to find a new way to "replace" the Olympics. A World Championship every two years is one possibility, as would be bringing Woman's and Men's Fastpitch Softball to the World Games, and the Commonwealth Games.

Wide television coverage is essential. This attracts the attention not only of fans but also sponsors. Sponsorship is needed to pay for the organization of tournaments and to Federations to invest in their countries for development of our sport.

There are great Tournaments all over the world - the Canada Cup, The Japan Cup, the World Cup Oklahoma, the Maccabiah Games, plans for an Australian Cup and the Haarlem Softball week in the Netherlands. Perhaps it is possible to combine one or more of these tournaments in one Worldwide competition or start a "Grand Tour" of tournaments.

This year, in European tournaments, we saw exciting games, strong and sometimes unexpected winners. ESF Technical officials and the Executive Council are evaluating the Competition forms that we received from many participants to keep what was good and to improve what needs adjustment.

The ESF will be in Brussels on 29 September to meet with the European Members of Parliament responsible for EU sports and we will use this time to discuss with them our plans for developing our sport in Europe. We need every ESF Federation to attend the ISF Congress in October. Many decisions have to be taken concerning the ISF and also the future of softball as an International sport. There will be time to discuss European issues in relation to the ISF.

## THE "TROPHÉE INTERNATIONAL LAFARGE 2009"

The 4th Trophée International Lafarge (T.I.L), men's international fastpitch tournament, took place on July 24, 25, 26th at the field of "la Tana" in Contes, 20km from Nice, France. 5 teams have contested the tournament: Roma Softball (Italy champions), Pasos Pardubice (Czech Republic), Die-Hards (Switzerland), BCF Paris (French vice-champions) and the host team, Contes' Cobras.

Most of the 15 games played during the competition were interesting and tight, level was high and scores were closed. The batters had to raise their level of hitting because of the experienced pitchers. Finally, Roma and Pardubice went to the final, and the Czech team conceded the victory to the powerful italian batters (12-5).

This tournament was a good training for all the teams, especially for Roma and Paris who will play the european cups this summer.
