	To speed up the procedures, it is necessary to receive the list of people part of your delegation by Friday, August 13, 2021.					
	Athletes can enter derogations ( <u>Deroghe - Covid-19 - Viaggiatori (salute.gov.it)</u> , with a COVID test negative certificate in Italian or in English taken in the 48 hours prior to departure, and filled in the Passenger Locator Forum.

Testing regime:	<ul> <li>48 Hours before entering the Host Country: negative antigen or molecular test. The negativity certificate is needed either in English or in Italian.</li> <li>Before the TC meeting: antigen test financed by each team (at a cost of 8 euros per person). The details of the arrangements will be communicated by the organizer (it is necessary to send to info.saronnosoftball@gmail.com and giorgia1975brambilla@gmail.com the list of people part of each delegation by Friday, August 13, 2021.).</li> <li>No other testing is required.         <ul> <li>However, all the relevant people might contact the 'COVID19 tests hub close to event venue' and schedule a test at their own expense.</li> <li>If testing is needed to enter the Home Country: contact the covid officers.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
In case of a positive test:	<ul> <li>Prior to the entrance in the Host Country: the person shall not travel to the event.</li> <li>In the Host Country: the positive person will be isolated and tested 72 hours after the first positive test.</li> <li>It is advisable that the teams agree with the hotels upon a 'isolation'</li> </ul>
