This Bulletin updates the general SE Covid Regulations with specific information for participants in Men's Softball European Super Cup 2021.

#### Travel:

Leaving Home country:	Exit requirements determined by home Government.
	This is under the whole responsibility of travelling Teams / individuals.
Arrival in Host Country:	Entry regulations determined by CZE Government – actual info here:
	Prime responsibility lies with travelers.
	Before traveling to the Czech Republic, foreigners traveling must
	fill in an <u>arrival form;</u>
	Please check all details carefully before leaving the Home Country.

### **Transportation:**

Teams:	No restrictions by transportation in own / rented vehicles.		
	Teams are responsible for their own transportation throughout and are advised to make full use of disinfectant wipes pre- and post- travel, and suitable mask discipline within their vehicles.		
Officials:	No restrictions.		

#### Testing:

Testing regime:	<ul> <li>No testing at the venue</li> <li>All SE officials and all team delegation has to approve their health by following before their the first entrance to the stadium:         <ul> <li>Fully vaccination (2 weeks after the second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson &amp; Johnson's Janssen vaccine)</li> <li>Negative PCR test 48 hours prior entrance to the Czech Republic (tests can be arranged in the city of Prague, please contact the COVID-19 Officer Vojtěch Albrecht albrecht@softball.cz)</li> <li>Proof of recovering from COVID-19 in the 180 days prior to the start of the tournament.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	The national COVID-19 vaccination certificate is the only proof document to be used. It is possible to use both the digital version on a mobile phone or the paper version – both need to have QR Code.







In case of a positive test:	All team members will be checked before their first game at the tournament. No exception will be admitted.  • Prior to the entrance in the Host Country: the person shall not travel to the event.	
•	<ul> <li>On the day of arrival in the Host Country: the positive person will be isolated and tested 72 hours after the first positive test. It is advisable that the teams agree with the hotels upon a 'isolation room' for potential positive person.</li> </ul>

#### **Bubble arrangements:**

Hotels: It is all Teams' responsibility to be aware of their accommodation to comply.	
	IF Teams share Hotel with Officials there must be no contact between individuals from each group unless absolute necessary, and then only with 2m distancing, with masks.
At venues:	Teams will be checked before the first game in the tournament.

#### Spectators & Media:

Spectators:	Spectators are allowed up to 5.000 people
	No tickets – free entrance
	To access the venue, it will be necessary for spectators to be:
	<ul> <li>fully vaccinated</li> <li>or to have a negative PCR test certificate (taken a maximum</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>of 7 days prior to the entrance)</li> <li>or a negative antigen test certificate (taken a maximum of 72 hours prior to the entrance).</li> </ul>
Media & accreditations:	To access the venue, it will be necessary for all accredited media to be:
	<ul> <li>fully vaccinated</li> <li>or to have a negative PCR test certificate (taken a maximum of 7 days prior to the entrance)</li> <li>or a negative antigen test certificate (taken a maximum of 72 hours prior to the entrance).</li> </ul>
