



## REPORT CASE

### Uganda Baseball and Softball Association Executive Committee Elections 2024

The WBSC hereby reports that the:

- Uganda Baseball Softball Association (UBASA)

has violated

- Article VI section ii) a) of the UBASA Constitution in that certain members were refused access to the venue, which consequently denied their participation in the election and voting process;
- Article VI section ii) d) of the UBASA Constitution in that members for whom WBSC did not receive the proof of payment, or who self-declared as non-paid-up members were refused access to the venue as observers;
- Article VI section iii) b of the UBASA Constitution in that the Executive Committee chose to conduct the elections without the requisite quorum being present; and
- Article 20.7 WBSC Ethics By-Law by refusing access to the election premises to eligible members.

As a result of the foregoing, the following sanctions have been decided:

1. To not recognise the USABA elections conducted on 27 April 2024.
2. To suspend provisionally the Uganda Baseball and Softball Association until the conduct of new proper elections under the supervision of the WBSC. This election shall be held within 6 months of the official notification of the decision (23/08/2024); otherwise, the suspension shall become final.

#### **UPDATE**

*The WBSC Executive Board approved on 5 March 2025, the lifting of the provisional suspension of the Uganda Baseball and Softball Association, following the elections of the new Executive Committee of the UBASA held on 15 February 2025.*
