

Procedures - Game Results

Scoring Live Games

Score live games are possible via the **Ballclubz** application which will generate scores and statistics onto the competition platform. (https://www.baseballsoftball.be/en/calendar)

- 1. Games can be scored via the **Ballclubz** app in case your club has a person who can handle the application (min. Scorer Level 1)
- 2. This procedure requires knowledge of the specifications of the application for scoring the games.
- 3. More information can be inquired at your league offices regarding development of scorers.

Providing Game Scores

Providing scores (without live scoring) of competition games will be communicated also via the application Ballclubz. This app will be used by the club responsible for providing the final score of completed games.

- 1. The home club representative will log in into the application Ballclubz with the club log in and password.
- 2. The home club must communicate all results (home games) of the past week via the mobile application Ballclubz at the latest on Monday 12.00!
- 3. Only 'completed played games' with a final score need to be given into the application.
- 4. Postponed, forfeited or cancelled games must be communicated via the 'Game modification Form' (see Game Modifications).

The manual can be used as a club responsible to get an overview of how to download, log in and submit scores for played games.

In case a game is not completed and needs to be modified because of certain circumstances we refer to the 'Game Modification' procedure.



Game modifications

Under 'Game modifications' we can understand that a certain game won't or isn't played on the original programmed date and time. The modifications we refer to are the following:

- Rescheduling
- Forfait
- Cancellation
- Discontinued

For all these modifications it will be **mandatory to communicate by the club** that will ask for the modification via an online form which is provided via the website.

Specific details regarding rescheduling games after communication via the form with 'Cancelation/Discontinued' can be found below.

Division	Rescheduled	Explanation
BD1 - SLD1 - SMD1	Automatically	A mandatory makeup date is published weekly for the upcoming games (MON-SUN) teams and officials are responsible to reschedule the game on the published date.
BD2 - SLD2	Optional	The first available makeup date is published for the upcoming week (MON-SUN) teams may, by mutual agreement, choose to change the published makeup date.
Other	On demand	A request to reschedule the game may be posted by a participating team if one or both participating teams post a request, the competition manger shall reschedule; teams may, by mutual agreement, suggest a makeup date to the competition manager.
