### INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR WRITTEN PROTEST.

The formal written protest must contain the following information:

- The date, time and place of the game.
- The name of the umpire.
- The rule and section of the Official Rules under which the protest is made.
- The decision and conditions surrounding the making of the decision.
- All essential facts involved in the matter protested.

### TIME TO LODGE AN OFFICIAL PROTEST:

The official written protest must be filed within **fifteen (15) minutes** after the end of the game. Use one (1)
