Presidential Report

Dear CEB Member Federations,

The current Executive board was elected one year ago on the 16th February 2013 in Bled, Slovenia.

The year 2013 was an intense and very emotional one for us. The whole CEB and IBAF family suffered heavily. Just one month ago, our Honorary General Secretary, Gaston Panaye died at the age of 87 in Antwerp. Also, back in early June, we faced the shocking news of the death of our dear friend and General Secretary, Xavier Mateu, who passed away far too early at only 50 years of age.

In Prague the Congress will decide on the position of a new General Secretary.

It was a great achievement that the C.E.B. competitions 2013 were all played according to the planned schedules. With the good work of all C.E.B. Officials, Commissions, and great support of the Local Organizing Commissions, the Competitions 2013 were a great success.

The two Senior Championship Qualifiers 2013 for the Euro 2014 were played in Vienna Austria, and Zurich Switzerland. These events proved very well our decision to play the Senior Qualifiers on an A, B and C level. These two events, in both countries, attracted nation-wide attention from thousands of Spectators. Press, Media, and National TV also carried daily news, and results.

The 2013 Club Champion of Europe, Unipol Fortitudo Bologna, received an invitation to participate in the Asia Series against the Champions of the Professional Leagues of Japan, Korea, Taiwan and Australia. Meetings with the Asian Organizers of this highly professional event, give us hope that C.E.B. can count on an invitation for the 2014 Asia Series as well.

C.E.B. will investigate in the year ahead, the possibility to use our European Cup event, as a step up to a European Professional League. For this we need the co-operation of the various stakeholders involved, and an experienced and financially strong Commercial partner.

For our future C.E.B. competitions we have the coming year, a heavy load of work. Due to the changes in the sequence at IBAF level, we have to discuss whether to adopt the sequence of all our European Championship as well. To achieve this, we need to know the future plans of the IBAF Premier 12, and the World Baseball Classic 2017, including the qualifiers in 2015 or 2016.

C.E.B. has started to work on a youth development program, in which our C.E.B. youth competitions are becoming more of interest to the advanced or higher level Federations.



Last March, the Senior National teams of Italy and the Netherlands, participated in the 3rd World Baseball Classic, organized by MLB, and sanctioned by IBAF as the World Championship. The results achieved by our representing European teams were truly amazing. The team from Italy succeeded for the first time to reach the 2nd round. The team from the Netherlands, who were also IBAF World Champions in 2011, made it through to the final round of the last four teams in San Francisco. Clearly at this professional level, our European players, and teams, have earned their right to be there, and are now very well respected by the Baseball fraternity all over the world.

On the financial aspects, the Executive searched for increasing the income for C.E.B. so as to avoid increasing the charges to our Members. This item is becoming more and more important to us, because IBAF did not start financial support for the continental confederations and no longer gives us the development funds which CEB received yearly up to 2009. Consequently the C.E.B. has few options but to continue with our cost cutting measures.

For the Olympic re-installment the IBAF and ISF decided to join our sports in the WSBC – the World Baseball & Softball Confederation. The road leading to this merger was very difficult, however it is also amazing what has been achieved so far. Hopefully there will soon be at a world level, a strong united body, with a transparent organisation and legal arrangements.

During the I.O.C. congress in September 2013 in Buenos Aires, the outcome of the vote was in favour of Wrestling, which was expected following the surprise removal of this sport earlier in 2013. The organisation of the 2020 Olympics was awarded to Tokyo, a city where baseball is very strong, and a part of sporting life there. There are presently great efforts being made by all parties involved, to get Baseball and Softball back on the program in 2020 in Japan already. The optimistic sounds around this possible return, gives us all the hope that this might succeed. At the end of 2014, all will be clear.

The C.E.B. Executive was very disappointed to learn that Italian C.E.B. Officials resigned as member of various C.E.B. Commissions, and other ones refused to accept requests to be Commission members. This happened on the instruction of the Italian Federation F.I.B.S. The C.E.B. requested the F.I.B.S. to enlighten us as to their action against us and to inform us what C.E.B. could do to improve this situation. Unfortunately we did not receive any answers. C.E.B. postponed up to now to fill in the open positions in the Technical Commission, Umpire Commission, and Scorer Commission, awaiting improvements in the co-operation with the Italian Federation. However C.E.B. must now fill in the open positions in the Commissions before the coming season starts.

In 2013 the “Beeball” clinics continued under the leadership of Mr. Anton Kops. This development project of CEB and ESF is a good example how our Baseball and Softball Federations can work together, and will be continued in 2014. Several Umpire and Scorer clinics were also given.

The launching of the new C.E.B. website is now taking place, and during the Congress in Prague, Rhena Landefeld will give the latest information on this. For the



Play-by-Play function, there have been some decisions taken to avoid the connection problems during periods where several events are running at the same time.

The CEB Executive is in the midst of establishing a new Strategic direction and plan that we hope will provide us with a clear vision to lead the organization for the next few years.

This plan, upon completion, will include a Vision and Purpose of where we want to take CEB, as well as a mission statement that will clearly define what our tasks will be going forward.

We will set long-term targets with specific goals that can be measured, and will better define the exact role of CEB and our member Federations.

Our approach will try to bring about

Greater Communication;

Greater Co-ordination;

Greater number of Baseball (youth) players in Europe

Greater Clarity; and

Greater Commitment of the CEB Executive, the member Federations, and our stakeholders.

We will set detailed objectives and action items, with specific timetables, and select Executive members who will be responsible for implementing each objective. We are now in the midst of discussing and defining this Strategic Plan and our intention is to communicate this to the member Federations during 2014, so that we can begin implementation for the 2015 season.

This project is being spearheaded by Executive member Peter Kurz and the Strategic and Marketing Committee, with the very capable assistance of John Boyd from the UK who went through a similar process with the UK Baseball & Softball Organisation.

Since the 31st December, Rhena Landefeld is no longer an employee of the C.E.B. and the Office in Frankfurt has been closed. Rhena was kindly prepared to assist C.E.B. in the first two months of this year in the organization and set up of the Prague Congress, and a few other important items including the new Website. Our special thanks to Rhena for all she did for us over these past years. She served as the key person between all our Federations, the Executive Board, and our Commissions and Officials, and did a wonderful job.

I herewith express also my gratitude and thanks to the members of the Executive, the Commissions and Officials for all their efforts to make it possible for C.E.B. to carry out our duties and responsibilities. With your help we can make the year 2014 even better! We are special looking forward to have a splendid Euro 2014 organised in a co-operation between the Czech Federation and the Club Regensburg (GER).

Technical Commission Report

The technical commission was re-elected and restructured after the election congress in Bled/Slovenia. The new commission is composed of the following members, Frantisek Bunta (SVK), Rainer Krankl (AUT), Juergen Elsishans (GER) and also by the chairman of the umpire commission, Paul Bokern (NED) and the chairman of the scorer commission, Pablo Carpio (ESP). One position remains open. Last May, Juergen Elsishans was appointed as Chairman of the TC by the Executive Committee.

The “old” technical commission met for the last time before the congress in Bled, to do the nominations and took all the necessary decisions for the 2013 tournaments. The first meeting of the “new” TC was held in Vienna (AUT) on December 13-14, 2013.

As in the past, all statistics and the “play by play” details for all 2013 CEB tournaments are published on the CEB website.

In 2013 a total of 15 tournaments were played. 9 Club and 6 National team competitions were organized all over Europe.

In June, 33 teams from 25 different federations participated in the various European Cup competitions.

In August, for the first time the European Champions Cup was played in Italy between the 2 winners of the European Cups (Bologna and Rimini).

In September, the 2 relegation tournaments for the European Cup were played.

In these competitions 17 technical commissioners, 51 international umpires and 9 international scorers were active.

In July, 42 National team selections from 24 different federations participated in the various European Championships and Qualifiers.

In total 12 Senior-teams, 10 Junior-teams, 14 Cadet-teams and 6 Juvenile-teams took part in these competitions.

CEB nominated 17 technical commissioners, 47 international umpires and 8 international scorers for these events.

Competitions 2013

European Cup A

The tournaments were played in Barcelona (ESP) and Regensburg (GER).

These were very well organized tournaments at the highest level of European baseball, and played at very good facilities. In Regensburg all games were available via “Livestream” on the internet.



European Cup Qualifiers

Played in Antwerp (BEL), Athens (GRE), Karlovac (CRO) and Paris/Senart (FRA).

For the tournament in Antwerp the team from Georgia withdrew an short notice and was fined according to the competition rules.

The preparation of the tournament in Senart was a little difficult due to communication problems with the LOC.

European Champions Cup

Played in Bologna and Rimini (ITA).

The Champions Cup was played for the first time instead of the Final Four.

Bologna won the title in 2 games.

Relegation European Cup

Played in Zuerich (SUI) and Rouen (FRA).

The play-off games were well organized, six teams competed for promotion, and the teams of Elizavetgrad (UKR) and Rouen (FRA) succeed in clinching a spot for their federation in the European Cup in 2014.

European Championships B-level

Played in Zuerich (SUI) and Vienna (AUT).

Both organizers did an outstanding job in organizing these championships. Both LOCs were very well organized; good crowds attended the games, with TV coverage at both venues.

European Championship Juniors (U18)

Played in Prague (CZE).

Well organized by the Czech Federation, and the clubs of Prague (Eagles, Tempo). Very experienced LOC, all challenges were resolved quickly.

European Championship Cadets (U15)

Played in Nykoping (SWE).

This event was a good example of how CEB youth events should be organized. Good fields, good arrangements, and a very active LOC made this tournament a success.

European Championship Cadets (U15) Qualifier

Played in Miesjka Gorka (POL).

The preparation of the tournament was difficult (poor communication with the LOC) but finally everything worked out ok, at least for this kind of youth tournament. For future tournaments there is scope to improve some things within the organization.

European Championship Juveniles (U12)

Played in Chocen (CZE).

As usual in the Czech Republic the federation and the organizer did a very good job. Very well organized event for youth baseball.



The cooperation between all parts of the technical commission and all the officials was very good for the whole year, and during all our tournaments.

The Technical Commission would like to thank all persons working in the various positions within CEB who made the 2013 season such a great success.

Our special thanks to Rhena Landefeld, who ran the CEB office for many years. She was a helpful and reliable partner at all times. Our best wishes to her in the future.

Annual Report 2012 Umpire Commission

Clinic

Umpires clinic was given in:

Kirovograd (UKR) 14 participants with Michael Larkin (RUS) as an instructor

In 2013 CEB had organised an umpires clinic for the new CEB umpires. The clinic was for the first time held. 8 umpires from 6 countries were together in Bratislava begin April. They passed the tests and received the CEB A-licence.

Instructors were Mojmir Jankovic (SVK), David Kulhanek (CZE) and Paul Bokern (NED).

In the next year we hope to organize a clinic for our top CEB-umpires in cooperation with IBAF.

Exchange umpires international tournaments in Europe

CEB tries always improving umpires. At now, arrangements were made with a few organisers of international tournaments to invite CEB-umpires to participate. The goal is to help umpires staying at a high level of umpiring.

European Tournaments Umpire evaluations

In 2013 the CEB Umpire Commission nominated in the 15 tournaments 95 umpires. In 207 games they were evaluated by a technical commissioner. The technical commissioner has to evaluate the game with the umpire and fill in a report. At the end of the tournament these reports were sent to the Umpire Commission and were administrated in order:

For 2014 we want to reduce the (big) differences in scores given by the evaluators. For the second time we were able to inform 25 National Federations about the results of their umpires during CEB Events in 2013.

CEB Umpire of the Year

During the Bled congress Frantisek Pribyl was chosen for the Umpire of the Year award. In 2012 was the award for Marco Taurelli (ITA); In 2011 for Jens Waider (GER); in 2010 for Dana Besczczynski (AUT); in 2009 for Sante de Franceschi (ITA) and in 2008 for Fred van Groningen Schinkel (NED)

Tournaments

Every umpire received a nomination sent by the office. In some situations we did not receive an answer. At the end CEB invited other umpires and billed 7 times euro 250 to countries who did not send umpires.

Next season CEB will not accept these matters and will invite earlier other umpires.

CEB Umpires

The list of CEB umpires we could use in 2013 consist with 137 names (150 in 2012) 35 names were new at that moment (in 2012: 16).

Matters of instruction

Already the CEB-umpires had received the dvd "the virtual umpire camp" The dvd shows the several umpire mechanics.

At the beginning of 2013 the 3-men mechanics were revised and published at the CEB-site.

Annual Report 2012 Scoring Commission

FIRST PART: REVISION OF THE YEAR

1) THE COMMISSION

The Scoring Commission is currently formed by Linda Steijger (NED) and Pablo Carpio (ESP) as chairman. There is one position vacant.

One more year, we regret that the only meeting we could have during 2013 was during the CEB Congress held in Slovenia. Bearing in mind the works we need to manage and advance during the year (technical documents, manuals, organization and support to scorers in championships...) we organize frequent sessions of Skype among us –together with Anna Maria Paini, IBAF Scoring Director-.

2) CLINICS

Scoring Clinic in Belgium: in the first weekend of February, 7 Belgian scorers had a clinic given by Linda Steijger, to update into the CEB Scoring System. One of these scorers was also taught to become a Statistics Director in near future. In the European Cup played in Antwerp (17-22 June) the scorers that joined the clinic worked the tournament under the supervision of Linda Steijger, which gave us a great opportunity to evaluate..

Scoring Clinic in Zurich: on the previous two days of the European Championship B level played at Zurich, there was a scoring clinic given by Pablo Carpio with a double objective: improve the knowledge of CEB Scoring system among 7 local scorers, and specially, change the scoring system from the “German system” to the CEB/IBAF scoring system. These scorers also did a great work in the consequent tournament, so we can say the clinic was highly useful and assure the change is also possible. Some weeks ago we have been informed that the Swiss Baseball and Softball Federation has decided to do big steps in 2014 season in order to change and adopt the CEB/IBAF scoring system, so we hope more national federations dare to do this change. They will receive all our support for that.

3) COMPETITIONS:

During 2013 season, 15 CEB tournaments were played all around Europe. All of their 205 games were scored, **transmitted through play by play and covered with highly detailed statistics information through the CEB website**, catching the interest of thousands of European baseball fans. **15 scoring directors and 59 scorers (international or national) made it possible**, joining in every venue the best possible technical background of the scorers and preparation, the collaboration of local organizing committees and the passion for baseball and for scoring.

The evaluation made by the Technical Commission as well by each Scoring Director is quite positive: every championship has been a useful opportunity to improve the knowledge and experience of the local scorers, unify criteria, learn from each other... We want to point out the hard work of the Scoring Directors: as you know, they “live” on the field during any Tournament: they are all time checking the



games, correcting the score sheets, doing the stats and daily reports, teaching the scorers, solving doubts...We would like everybody in CEB to realize this and give value to this work, whose “output” is well known by everybody, but not its “input”, maybe.

We want also notice that in general, all Scoring Directors have reported a **good collaboration and disposal by the Local Organizing Committees** in all matters about logistics, food and lodging and scoring matters. Only a few specific remarks or details to be improved have been reported too.

The main (and big) problem we had to face is already well known by all: starting in some competitions in June, there were several **failures and breakdown of the server**. We have to say clearly that none of these problems in any tournament were due to the action of the data entry and scoring directors or to the program itself.

On the opposite, the scorers and scoring directors made their best to keep on working and covering the competition, and sending informations via Skype and phone trying to warn and solve the situation as soon as possible. In addition to them, about this problem and its solution, we want to **thank** specially two persons: **Feiko Drost**, a Dutch scorer who lend for free his own servers to the play by play of CEB competitions and **Fausto Nardi** – webmaster of competitions site-.

During 2013 we also have done relevant steps toward **standardization of daily reports**, trying to unify their contents and layouts. And we gave special attention to the **Evaluation Reports** written by each Scoring Director, that provide us with useful background about all matters related to scoring.

4) CEB SCORERS IN IBAF COMPETITIONS

5) INTERNATIONAL CONTACTS:

The CEB Scoring Commission keeps working on closely with Anna Maria Paini and the IBAF Scoring Commission for the common goal of finishing the scoring manual – expected to be published this year- and also to prepare technical materials for clinics.

There are also communications with the ESF Scoring Commission to coordinate criteria and documents.



2nd PART: SPECIFIC GOALS FOR 2014

Technical area:

- Finish IBAF/CEB Scoring and distribute it all around Europe.
- Improve the number and quality of scorers in CEB countries.
- Improve the number of national federations to use the CEB Scoring System.
- Attend clinics after requests of national federations (at this moment: Czech Baseball Association) for any kind of clinic: beginners/advance/statistics/changing the system clinics.
- Suggest/offer European Scoring/Statistics Clinics: specially aimed to CEB countries with less scorers able to work in CEB Scoring System and/or with the statistics program. Each federation sends one/two of the more experienced scorers to a general clinic, with the idea to bring and share the knowledge in their countries.
- Produce technical materials for clinics.
- Elaborate a common form to write the "Evaluation Report" by the Scoring Directors, that will be a part of the "general" evaluation report done by the Technical Commission chairman in each Tournament.

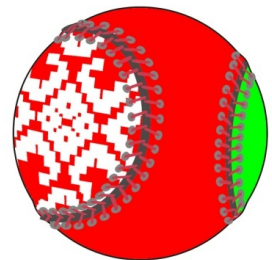

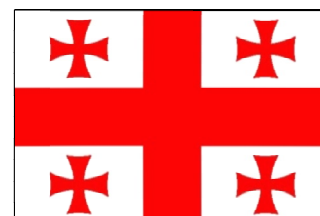
