Federation Cups for their nation.



Miejski Klub Sportowy Stal Kutno

Commonly known as Stal Kutno, is a leading Polish baseball club based in Kutno. Established in 1985, the club has played a pivotal role in the development of baseball in Poland. History and Achievements:

- 1980s and 1990s: In its early years, the club secured Polish championship titles in 1988, 1989, 1991, and 1992. Notably, in 1990, Stal Kutno became the first Polish club team to participate in the European Cup held in Paris.
- 21st Century: The club continued its streak of successes, clinching additional Polish championship titles in 1995–1997, 2002–2008, 2010–2011, 2014–2015, and 2019–2023. As of 2023, MKS Stal Kutno has amassed a total of 21 Polish championship titles, making it the most decorated club in the history of Polish baseball.
- Infrastructure: In 1995, Little League International signed an agreement with the town of Kutno to establish the European Little League Training Center. The complex, completed in 1996, comprises five fields, including the Edward Piszek Stadium and the Stanisław Musiał Stadium, as well as dormitories for players. These facilities serve both local teams and international youth tournaments.
- Recent Developments: In 2024, the senior team of MKS Stal Kutno secured its twenty-first Polish championship title.

With its longstanding tradition and numerous successes, MKS Stal Kutno continues to play a crucial role in promoting and developing baseball in Poland, contributing significantly to the sport's popularity nationwide.

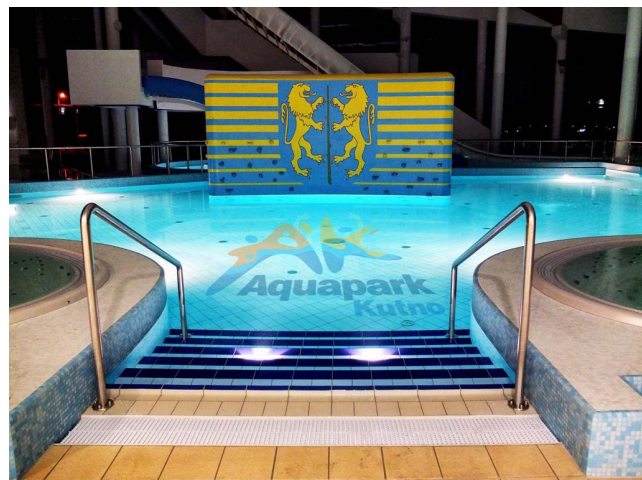




Municipal Center for Sports and Recreation

The municipal stadium on Kosciuszko Street was modernized in 2003. It has a full infrastructure useful for the organization of events not only of a sporting nature - 2 full-size fields to play soccer - athletic facilities including running track, long jump, dart throw, jumps for distance, and high jump - full sanitary and office facilities with locker rooms, gym and sauna.

As a whole, the city stadium is successfully fulfilled in organizing matches of the 3rd soccer league, the Kutno Rose Olympics, spartakiads, athletics Thursdays, inter-state soccer matches, Polish Cup finals in women's soccer, family festivals, corporate events.



Aquapark Kutno was put into operation in May 2012. The facility took the shape of a quarter circle, following the pattern of nearby baseball fields - the facilities of the Little League Baseball Training Center.

The aquapark is equipped with, among other things :- sports swimming pool, an oval-shaped recreational pool , two neck massage devices, two for side and jet massage two air geysers, five air beds and a rushing river.

The Kutno facility is also equipped with a wellness and fitness complex. Among other facilities , our clients enjoy a steam room, dry sauna, solarium, relaxation room, two squash rooms , a four-lane bowling alley and two exercise rooms.

Kutno City of Roses

Kutno is a city located in central Poland, within the Łódź Voivodeship, situated along the Ochna River. It serves as the seat of Kutno County and the rural Gmina Kutno. As of December 31, 2022, the city had a population of 41,231 residents.

History: The earliest mentions of Kutno date back to the 13th century. The city was granted municipal rights in 1386. Throughout its history, Kutno has experienced various periods of development and challenges, serving as an important trade center due to its location at the intersection of key communication routes.

Economy: Thanks to its central location and well-developed transportation infrastructure, Kutno is a significant communication hub. The city hosts the Kutno Subzone of the Łódź Special Economic Zone, attracting both domestic and foreign investors.

Culture and Events: Kutno is known as the "City of Roses" due to its tradition of cultivating these flowers. Annually, the Rose Festival takes place here, attracting flower enthusiasts from across the country and Europe.

Education and Sports: In Kutno, there are numerous educational institutions, including primary and secondary schools, as well as the State Music School. In the realm of sports, Kutno is recognized for its active engagement in baseball and softball. The Municipal Sports Club (MKS) "Stal" Kutno has achieved notable success in baseball, while the "Lions" Kutno Softball Club promotes and develops softball within the city. Additionally, the Softball Sports Club is fostering the growth of the sport in the nearby town of Krośniewice.

Landmarks and Attractions: Among the most notable landmarks in Kutno are the 19th-century classical town hall, currently housing the Saxon Palace Museum, and the 18th-century Gierałty Palace, which accommodates the State Music School. It's also worth visiting Traugutt Park, a recreational area for residents and the site of activities organized by the Kutno Cultural Center.

Due to its location, rich history, and dynamic development, Kutno is a significant point on the map of central Poland and Europe.

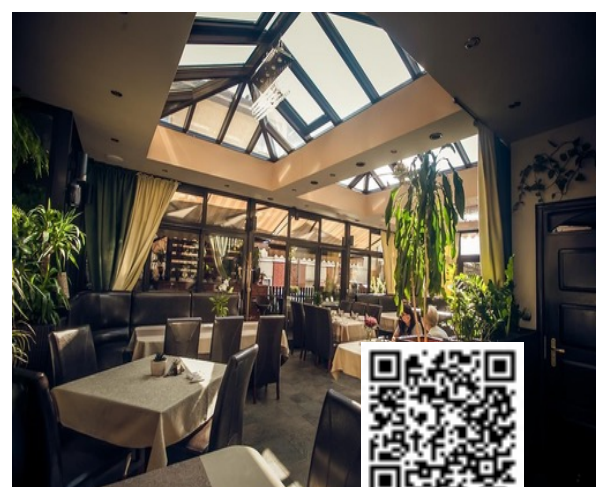
